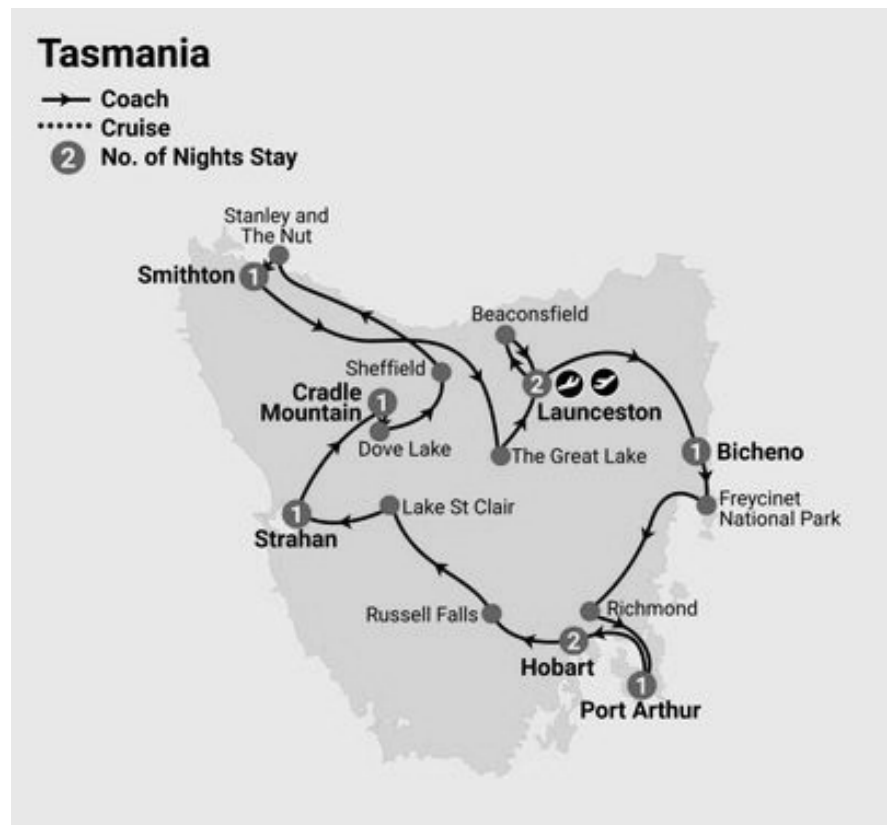

TOUR ITINERARY

DAY 1

Destination	Launceston 🚗 Beaconsfield 🚗 Launceston
Meals included	Dinner
Hotel	4 ★ Hotel Grand Chancellor, or similar

On arrival, you'll transfer to your hotel in Launceston. After settling in, enjoy a picturesque journey following the Tamar River. Visit the gold mining town of Beaconsfield, and take a guided tour of the Mine & Heritage Centre. Enjoy canapes and a Welcome Drink at the iconic James Boag's Brewery, followed by a Welcome Dinner this evening.

DAY 2

Destination	Launceston 🚗 Bicheno
Meals included	Breakfast, Dinner
Hotel	3 ★ Beachfront Bicheno, or similar

Drive through the scenic wine-producing area of northern Tasmania. Traverse Weldborough Pass and stop at East Coast Natureworld. Here, meet a Tasmanian devil and other native animals.

Continue on to the seaside town of Bicheno. Later, you might like to gain a special insight into the lives of little penguins (own expense).

BICHENO PENGUIN TOUR

Gain an insight into the lives of little penguins, often called fairy penguins, without disturbing their daily routine.

DAY 3

Destination	Bicheno 🚗 Freycinet National Park 🚗 Richmond 🚗 Port Arthur
Meals included	Breakfast, Dinner
Hotel	3 ★ Port Arthur Motor Inn, or similar

Home to pristine beaches, rugged landscapes and granite peaks, Freycinet is a place of breathtaking natural beauty. Explore the park and take in the stunning surrounds.

Continue south to Richmond, home to the historic Richmond Bridge. Built by convicts in the 1820s, it is Australia's oldest bridge.

On the way to Port Arthur, see how nature and time have created spectacular rock formations such as the Tessellated Pavement and Tasman Arch.

Destination	Port Arthur 🚗 Hobart

Soak up the old-world charm and lively culture of the Tasmanian capital today.

Wander around Salamanca Place, visit Constitution Dock and enjoy the views from the city's picturesque harbour. The Apple Isle also has a growing reputation for high quality food and wine, with Hobart at its core.

Visit the famous Salamanca Market and peruse the treasures of Tasmania at more than 300 stalls, which showcase the best of the island's fresh and famous produce.

BRUNY ISLAND ADVENTURE CRUISE

Cruise along the coast to see wildlife of Bruny Island and enjoy a delicious lunch.

SOUTHWEST WILDERNESS EXPERIENCE

Fly over some of south-east Tasmania's most remote wilderness and land at Melaleuca for a scenic cruise to the stunning Port Davey and Bathurst Harbour.

DAY 6

Destination	Hobart 🚌 Russell Falls 🚌 Lake St. Clair 🚌 Strahan
Meals included	Breakfast, Dinner
Hotel	3 ★ Strahan Village Hilltop, or similar

Framed by lush vegetation, the three-tiered Russell Falls is a jewel in the crown of Mt Field National Park. After a short walk to marvel at the famed falls, continue to World Heritage-listed Cradle Mountain-Lake St Clair National Park.

Here, relish the pristine wilderness on the shores of Lake St Clair. Later, travel by coach to the town of Strahan and enjoy a buffet dinner at View 42° Restaurant and Bar this evening.

Take in the serenity of Cradle Mountain-Lake St Clair National Park. This is quintessential Tasmania, where breathtaking landscapes are covered with alpine flora.

Visit Waldheim Chalet and marvel at the views from the shores of Dove Lake.

Then travel via the mural town of Sheffield to Stanley, set in the shadow of The Nut. Later, arrive in Tasmania's north-western town of Smithton.

Journey to the Great Lake and admire the vast body of water that draw anglers from all over Australia. Continue to Launceston, where you will enjoy a Farewell Dinner and Drink.

HOW TO BOOK & PAYMENTS

Deposit & Payments

- Book now and secure your package with only a \$200 deposit per person.
- Pay a 2nd instalment of \$710 per person within 28 days.
- You will then be invoiced for final payment 100 days prior to departure.

Booking Process

- Select the purple 'Reserve Your Seat' tab to begin your booking (you must 'Sign Up' first by entering your email and creating a password)
- Then select the purple 'Book now' tab of the tour you have selected
- Select your Departure Date, Departure City, Number of Passengers, Room Configuration, any Upgrade Options, and enter any Special Requests
- Click the purple 'Proceed to Secure Checkout' tab
- Enter your credit card or PayPal details to secure your deposit/payment. You may also pay via BPAY (not available within 70 days of departure)
- Once your order is complete, you will be prompted to complete a Booking Form so that we can fulfil your booking
- Your position on the tour will be confirmed within 48 hours of completing your order. If your place cannot be confirmed, a full refund of the deposit will occur.
- You will then be allocated and contacted by one of our Dedicated Support Agent's (within 48 hours) who will support you right up until you return from your journey
