DAY 1

Destination	Adelaide
Meals included	
Hotel	4 ★ Crowne Plaza Adelaide, or similar

Welcome to Adelaide! On arrival, collect your vehicle from Hertz Airport depot and make your way to your hotel. The rest of your day is free to explore Adelaide at your own pace.

Check in & arrival information.

Please advise your arrival flight details into Adelaide at least 30 days prior to departure. Alternatively, let us know if you will arrive by land for your car to be available at Adelaide Downtown depot.

Hotel check in is at 2pm. Should you arrive earlier than this, hotel staff will do all possible to check you in as soon as possible. If your room is not available before check-in time, you are welcome to leave your luggage in storage and explore the surrounding area.

DAY 2

Destination	Adelaide 🚗 Port Augusta
Meals included	Breakfast
Hotel	4 ★ Majestic Oasis Apartments, or similar

This morning begins your journey north to Port Augusta, once the main port for the Southern Australian area. The port was the point where wheat and wool were loaded on clipper ships and transported around the world. By the 1970s that had stopped and the town, exploiting its unique position, became the starting point the Nullarbor Plain.

Approximate distance driven: 310km - 4hrs

DAY 3

Destination	Port Augusta 🚗 Quorn 🚗 Flinders Ranges
Meals included	Breakfast
Hotel	3 ★ Wilpena Pound Resort, or similar

Today's drive continues north, approximately 160km, to the ancient geological region of the Flinders Ranges or Ikara as it is known to the traditional Aboriginal owners. It's a place rich in Aboriginal history and home to a vast array of wildlife.

On route, make sure to stop at Quorn - historic town in the Flinders Ranges which came into existence as an important railhead. While here, a visit to the Pichi Richi Railway is a must. Built in the 1870s, this unique railway is the last remaining operating portion of the "Old Ghan" narrow-gauge line. After being abandoned in the 1950's, the Railway was revived in 1974 by the volunteers of the Pichi Richi Railway Preservation Society who have progressively restored a remarkable collection of heritage locomotives and carriages.

Tonight you'll be nearing the Wilpena Pound. A massive bowl almost 100 kilometres wide that stands above the surrounding plains, looks like a crater but the rim is actually made up of the stumps of huge mountains, believed to have been as high as the Himalayas, that have been eroded over millennia. It was called a pound by the early settlers in the 1850s – they thought it looked like a traditional sheep pen.

DAY 4

Destination	Flinders Ranges ➔ Scenic Flight Wilpena Pound ➔ Flinders Ranges
Meals included	Breakfast
Hotel	3 ★ Wilpena Pound Resort, or similar

This morning you are in for a real treat! Take to the skies on a 20 minute scenic flight over Wilpena Pound. Completing a circuit of Wilpena Pound where your pilot will point out the Elder Range, Edeowie Gorge, Heysen Range, Lake Torrens, Bunyerroo Gorge, Brachina Gorge, St Mary Peak and the Pound Gap. You will clearly see how the Flinders Ranges appears to be a backbone on the landscape. This is an extraordinary sight and great for photographers.

This scenic flight is operated by the Wilpena Pound Resort and the resort staff will direct you to the meeting point.

After returning to the ground, enjoy the rest of the day to explore the Flinders Ranges at your own pace. Having a vehicle gives you the perfect opportunity to access a huge range of walks or points of interest.

DAY 5

Destination	Flinders Ranges 🚗 Clare Valley
Meals included	Breakfast
Hotel	4 ★ Clare Country Club, or similar

This morning, pack the car and begin your journey South along Flinders Ranges Way towards the Clare Valley. The Clare Valley is home to over 40 cellar doors and wineries, boasting some of the best Riesling in Australia.

Approximate distance driven: 294km - 3.5hrs

DAY 6

Destination	Clare Valley 🚗 Adelaide
Meals included	Breakfast
Hotel	4 ★ Crowne Plaza Adelaide, or similar

Today start slowly, maybe sleep in a little. Today's drive is an easy 144km to Adelaide. Before heading back Adelaide, perhaps visit the Powder Magazine - erected in 1847 it's the oldest remaining mine building in Australia. Alternatively, you may want to see the Unicorn Brewery Cellars, which was built in 1873 and consisted of a tall malting tower, offices, cooper's workshop, steam engine and boiler to operate the pumps, and manager's residence. The cellars were excavated and completed in 1873. Due to new licensing laws, introduced at the turn of the century, the Brewery closed in 1902 and the buildings were demolished for their stone in 1911.

Approximate distance driven: 144km - 2hrs

DAY 7

Enjoy a leisurely breakfast with expansive desert views, followed by a stop at the outback ghost town of Cook. A spectacular dinner under the stars awaits at Rawlinna (seasonal), the Nullarbor outpost that borders a 'little' sheep station of a mere 8,000 square kilometres.

DAY 9

Destination	 Perth

After a restful sleep, sit down for breakfast as the picturesque rolling hills of the Avon Valley pass you by. Perth is your final destination, arriving mid-afternoon. Upon arrival make your way to your hotel. A taxi or Uber ride will cost you between \$10-15.

DAY 10

Destination	Perth  Rottnest Island  Perth
Meals included	Breakfast
Hotel	4 ★ Travelodge Perth, or similar

Make your way to Barrack Street Jetty and board the Rottnest Express ferry to Rottnest Island, located 22km offshore. Then explore the beauty and tranquility of Rottnest as you sit back and relax in the comfort of an air conditioned coach. This 90-minute circumnavigation of the island takes you out to some of Rottnest's most spectacular locations including the Wadjemup Lighthouse and the rugged West End and provides you with a complete interpretation of the island through a passionate and knowledgeable crew. This tour will provide you with an insight into Rottnest's cultural and historical heritage, diverse wildlife and fauna and social heritage. You will also have a chance to step outside and have a stroll along the boardwalk at the majestic look-out point at West End.

DAY 11

Destination	Perth  Margaret River
Meals included	Breakfast
Hotel	4 ★ Stay Margaret River, or similar

Today collect your vehicle from Hertz Downtown Depot and drive to Margaret River- one of Australia's largest wine regions. With more than 200 vineyards, Margaret River produces more than 25% of Australia's premium wine.

DAY 12

Today enjoy a guided Margaret River wine experiencing the region's amazing food, wine and culture. You will be collected from your accommodation at approximately 9.30am and get the day started with a coffee tasting at a local roaster before heading to your first boutique winery experience for the day. Experience first hand the subtle flavours of extra virgin olive oils before enjoying a relaxing lunch and cleansing ale at a local brewery. The afternoon will see you two cellar doors including a cheese & wine pairing. Finish off the day with a visit to a chocolate factory to indulge in all things cocoa.

DAY 13

Destination	Margaret River
Meals included	Breakfast
Hotel	4 ★ Stay Margaret River, or similar

Today is free for you to continue exploring the area. If wine is the name of the game, take your time to explore some of the 90 cellar doors in the region.

Alternatively, exploring the caving system is also a popular activity in Margaret River. It is difficult to choose the best cave. You can marvel at the reflections on Lake Cave's permanent lake, be dwarfed in Jewel Cave's enormous chambers and take it easy on the Mammoth Cave self-guided tour. At Yallingup's Ngilgi Cave, you will learn the Aboriginal legend as you look up at limestone shawl formations- or delve deeper into the cave on an adventure tour. Cave opening hours and tours start from 9am and finish between 4pm and 5pm. Entry fee is approximately \$22.50 per adult.

If travelling between late July and August, you want to consider a cruise to witness the mighty Humpback on their migration path. This tour departs from Augusta, 50km south of Margaret River

MARGARET RIVER WHALE WATCHING

Today you will make your way to Augusta, approx 50kms from your accommodation. Your tour will start on an amazing luxury catamaran to take you out to the magnificent Western Australia Whales. The vessel has 5 viewing decks over three levels from which you can sight the magnificent Humpback, Southern Right and occasionally, the very rare Blue Whale along with Seals, Dolphins and migratory bird life from all over the world.

Season runs from May to August

DAY 14

Destination	Margaret River 🚗 Busselton 🚗 Bunbury 🚗 Fremantle
Meals included	Breakfast
Hotel	4 ★ Hougoumont Fremantle, or similar

Start the last driving leg of your trip.

On the way north, you may want to stop at Busselton Jetty. This 150+ year old timber jetty stretches 1.84km into the Geographe Bay - making it the longest timber jetty in the Southern Hemisphere. Whether you walk to the end or take the jetty train, make sure to check out the Underwater Observatory for a glimpse of the sea life that inhabits this artificial environment.

Further north, you may want to pay a visit to the Dolphin Discovery Centre, in Bunbury. Walk down to the “interaction zone” for an opportunity to say to the many dolphins that visit this bay all year round. There is no entrance fee but please make sure you follow the instructions of dolphin volunteers

If you're feeling peckish, you may want to explore Bunbury Farmers market, which opens daily from 7.30am to 5.30pm.

DAY 15

Destination	Fremantle
Meals included	Breakfast
Accommodation	N/A

Today your Indian Pacific adventure comes to an end in Fremantle. Return your car at Hertz Fremantle depot at the same time as (or before than) you picked it up from Perth (Dropping off any later may result in Hertz additional fees)

Make your way to Perth airport. A taxi or Uber ride will cost you between \$30 and \$35.
